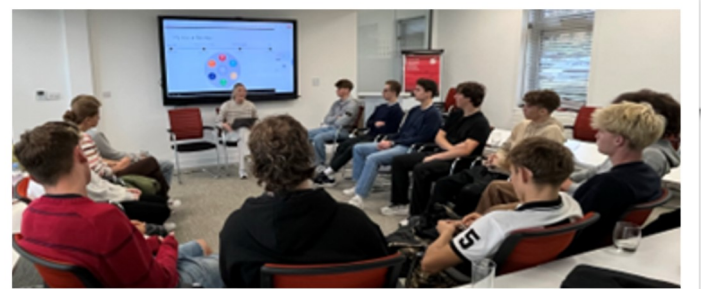

Due to Military operations, the Year 10 **Army Residential Work Experience** was cancelled last Term, so the students, now Year 11, have been experiencing life in the Army in the slightly colder months of September and October!

The start of the School year has seen the rolling out of **Post 16 options** information to Year 11 students, including assemblies on Apprenticeships, T levels, and a visit from New College, Swindon. **Post 18 options** have also been rolled out to Years 12 and 13, including assemblies and talks on apprenticeships, gap years, and university.

Every year we collect **destination data** for Year 11 and 13 students to track the Post 16 and Post 18 pathways they take. This data provides valuable insights into students' career choices and the effectiveness of the St John's careers programme.
