The Hate U Give by Angie Thomas

Synopsis:

Sixteen-year-old Starr lives in two worlds: the poor neighbourhood where she was born and raised and her posh high school in the suburbs. The uneasy balance between them is shattered when Starr is the only witness to the fatal shooting of her unarmed best friend, Khalil, by a police officer. Now what Starr says could destroy her community. It could also get her killed.

Inspired by the Black Lives Matter movement, this is a powerful and gripping YA novel about one girl's struggle for justice.

This is a very powerful and thought provoking teenage novel which is of huge importance at the moment. It documents the struggle many black people face on a daily basis and why they are fighting for change.

Read it, share it, discuss it and I dare you to not be moved by it.

This week's writing prompt: As lockdown begins to ease, and we begin to be more free to see our friends and family (albeit in a strange and socially distanced way) the sunshine that we've had feels like such a blessing. To be able to sit or roam outside in the sunshine is bliss. And so, you might feel a loss of freedom, when the sunshine we've grown so used to is stolen from us and replaced with rain.

In these last few damp days, you might have found yourself a little more confined to the house. You might have felt frustrated by that and you may already be longing for the sunshine to return, together with the freedom that brings.

So, take a moment to reflect on what it may be like for those people who are less able to leave the house, even if the sun is shining. Painted By Hans Holbein the Younger in 1533.

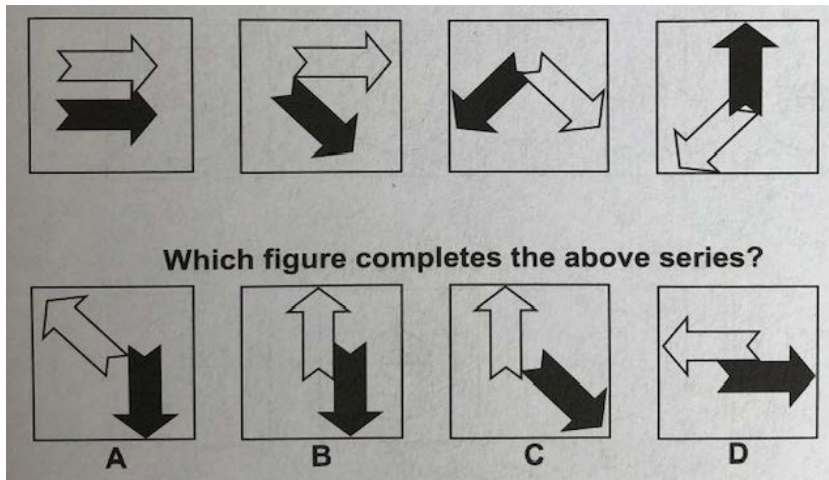
The two men in the painting are Jean Dinteville and Georges De Selve, and the object depicted is a Celestial Globe.



Jean de Dinteville (left) was the ambassador to England from the French court of King François I. His companion is Georges de Selve, a French bishop and diplomat.

Last Week's Abstract Reasoning Puzzle



The answer is B

Each of the arrows is moving by an increasing multiple of 45 degrees. So the black arrow rotates by 1×45 , and then $2 \times$ and then $3 \times$. In the next frame, it should therefore have rotated by $4 \times 45 = 180$ degrees, so we expect it to point downwards.

The white arrow follows the same pattern but lagging by one frame (i.e. its first rotation is 0×45 degrees). So we expect it to have rotated by 3×45 degrees and therefore it should be pointing upwards.

Well done to Louis Edmondson who was first with the correct answer!

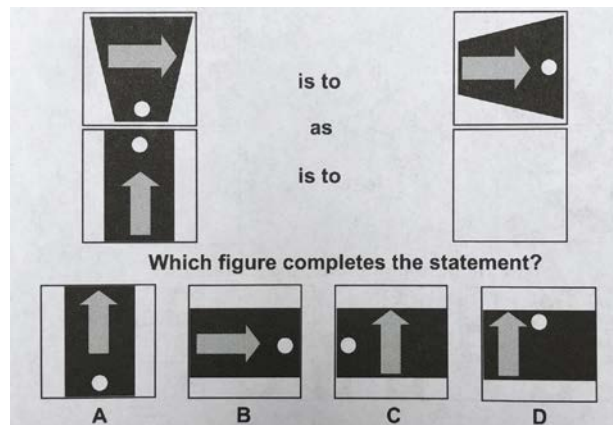

Photo Of The Week



Afghan Girl is a 1984 photographic portrait of Sharbat Gula (born c. 1972), taken by photojournalist Steve McCurry. It appeared on the June 1985 cover of National Geographic.

With the worldwide popularity of the Afghan Girl came the trip that would track her down Seventeen years after the photograph was taken, McCurry returned to Afghanistan with a team from National Geographic to try and find the “the Afghan Girl”. Many people presented themselves as the girl in the picture but McCurry had visual pointers to the real Afghan Girl.

The National Geographic crew spoke to hundreds of people even to some that said that the girl was dead. One man breathed a sigh of relief into their mission – he not only knew the girl but her brother as well. He was even willing to bring her to them since the area in which she lived by then was dangerous.

Digital iris recognition confirmed that she was indeed the Afghan Girl. She is



pictured below.

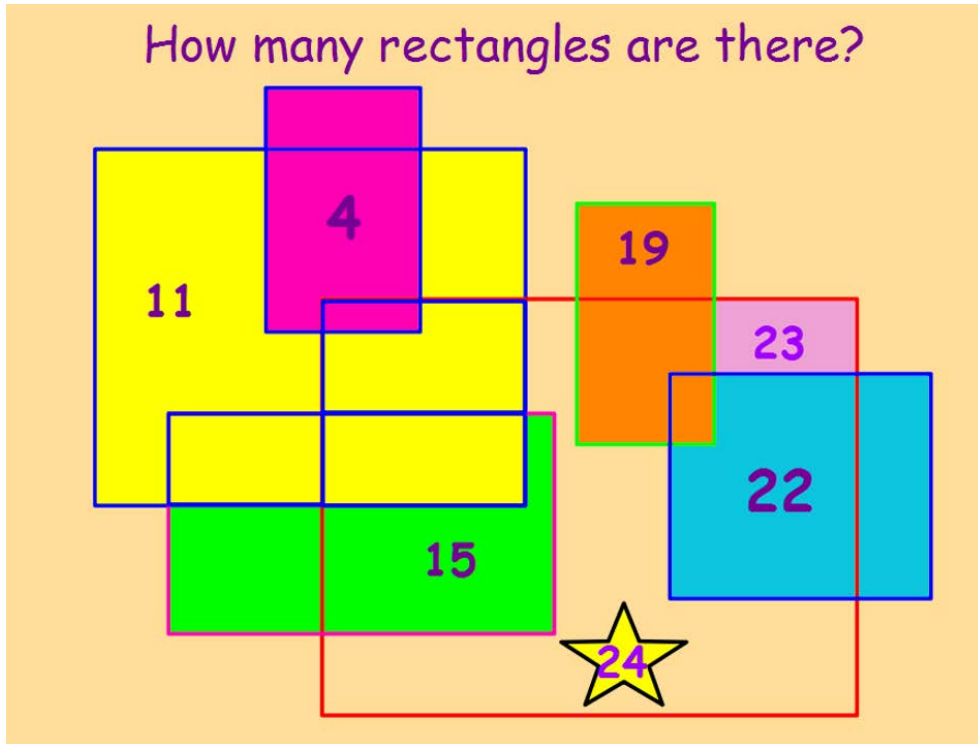
Ted Talks

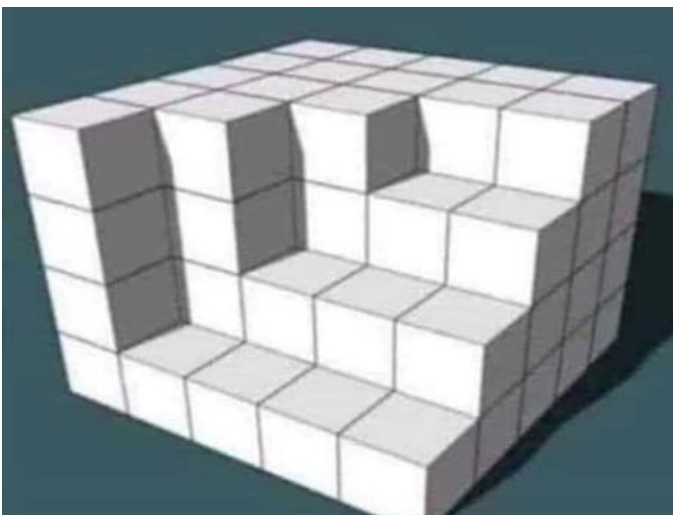
