Dear Applicants to St John's Sixth Form and Parents

We are very pleased that you have chosen to apply to the Sixth Form at St John's and I am writing to let you know the next steps in the application process.

We are organising a Guidance Day on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March in order to offer an interview to all Sixth Form applicants. This will provide an opportunity to discuss your course choices and predicted grades and answer any questions you may have about your application. The member of staff conducting your Sixth Form interview will arrange a time via Teams and an invitation will be sent to you by Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March via your school email. During the interview students will have their cameras on and the interview will be recorded for safeguarding reasons. Students may wish to have their interview in a downstairs room or keep their bedroom door open.

I would also like you to be aware that we are unfortunately not able to offer A Level Latin and BTEC Music, although we are offering A level Music. I am sorry if you were hoping to study either of these courses and, for those students who are affected, we will discuss this during interview.

Following your interview, you can expect to receive a formal letter offering you a place in the Sixth Form which will be conditional on you achieving the necessary grades for the courses you have applied for.

Later in the year I will outline to you how you can prepare for your new Sixth Form courses in September so that you can be proactive in preparing for the future. This will involve some summer preparation work and I will let you have further details nearer the time.
