Year 12 Circular Economy Day – Tuesday 7th December 2021

On Tuesday 7th December all Year 12 students will be taking part in St John's first Circular Economy Day. Students will follow a bespoke programme of activities from 8.40am until 3.00pm and will not attend any of their usual timetabled lessons. Students will be expected to participate fully in all activities and so will not be permitted to leave early. All students will start the day in the Theatre at 8.40am and will be timetabled in tutor groups through the day.

Students will experience the day as young adults, as consumers of food, textiles, household and electronic products. They will explore the impact that decisions they make can have on people around the world and the environment.

The day is about positive change and students will explore what is meant by the term 'Circular Economy' and how their lifestyles can help the UK work towards a more sustainable future. The day will involve several workshops, activities and talks from Tin Horse design, Packaging Not Included and Refashion My Town. The timetable for the day will be emailed to students in advance and promoted within tutor time. It is important that students are organised and punctual to sessions so external speakers and workshops can run without interruption.

There will be displays and opportunities for students to speak with visiting experts on the day about careers and industries for those interested in exploring future possibilities.
