Mb/letter to Yr 13 parents update Mar21

Dear Parents/Carers of Year 13 students

I am writing to update you on our plans over the coming weeks for Year 13 students. Whilst some things still remain uncertain and we await further guidance from DfE and Ofqual, we are clear about our plans for the March assessments.

The assessments will take place from 24th – 29th March. During this period A level lessons will be suspended so students can concentrate on their assessments. BTEC students who do not have assessments in March will need to check with their teachers whether they have lessons but preparation for assessments is the main priority. Students should come in for their assessments and are free to leave after they have finished. If they would like to study in school the Sixth Form library and study corridor will be available but unfortunately the study room, G182, is being used for assessments. There is no need to attend tutorial over the assessment days.

More details about the planned May assessments will be shared as soon as we are able.

A number of parents have asked me about the leaving date for Year 13 this year. It is likely to be between May half term and the 18th June but will be confirmed as soon as we are able. The Year 13 Leavers' Dinner has been moved to the 25th June (subject to restrictions being lifted on 21st June). Results day has been moved forward to Tuesday 10th August.
