Duke of Edinburgh's Award Enrolment – Silver Award (Year 10)

We are pleased to be able to offer all Year 10 students the opportunity to enrol onto the Silver Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

The Silver expedition section has three elements; a training day, a practice expedition and an assessment expedition, which are all compulsory parts of the programme. The planned dates for these are listed below – please make a note of these as students will be required to attend all three.

Transport to and from the expedition areas unfortunately cannot be provided by St John's or BXM Expeditions. The expeditions will take place locally to the school, (no more than 30 minutes away) and for this reason, parents are asked to drop off and collect participants from the expeditions. We would encourage everyone to lift share; the exact details of where and when to drop off/collect will be confirmed nearer the time.
