IMPORTANT – please note the following dates:

The Local Authority (LA) will send an application form to primary schools for every parent resident within the LA whose child attends a Wiltshire school and is in his/her last year of primary education. Applications can be made on-line via the Local Authority website. www.wiltshire.gov.uk

All application forms **must** be returned to the LA by **12 midnight on 31st October 2021**.

1st March 2022 – National Offer Date – Notification of offers are dispatched to parents from the Local Education Authority for all applications submitted by 31st October 2020.

15th March 2022 is the deadline for parents to accept the place offered. If you do not respond by this date it will be assumed that the place offered has been declined.

Guidance notes will accompany the Application Form from County Hall and there will also be an Admissions Helpline.

If you have applied for a place at St John's and have been unsuccessful, you will be notified of your right to appeal. Please note that the Appeals Panel will meet in **early June 2022**.

If you decide that St John's is the school for your child, and a place is allocated to them, we will promise to deliver an outstanding education.
