

St John's Marlborough CCTV Notice

CCTV images are gathered both internally and externally to:

- protect the school buildings and school assets, both during and after school hours;
- promote the health and safety of staff, pupils and visitors;
- Safeguard for staff & students
- prevent bullying;
- reduce the incidence of crime and anti-social behaviour (including theft and vandalism);
- support law enforcement in a bid to deter and detect crime;
- assist in identifying, apprehending and prosecuting offenders; and
- ensure that the school rules are respected so that the school can be properly managed.

This may include sharing footage with the police or other law enforcement agencies, or our insurers where necessary.

Data is only stored on the secure CCTV server and is automatically overwritten after 28 days, however If an incident occurs, the data will be stored on a secure file server until the incident has been resolved.

All access to the CCTV is audited and approval must first be given by a member of the Senior Leadership Team or a Head of Year before any footage can be viewed.
