**Yrs. 8, 9 & 10 German Exchange 2026:  
German Visitors to England – Monday 9 March to Monday 16 March 2026  
English Students to Germany – Monday 22 June to Sunday 28 June 2026**

Following a successful information evening we are now ready to move forward with signing students up to the 2026 German Exchange trip. An exchange is a unique opportunity! It is often the only time when you can experience life in a German family first-hand, really gain an insight into what it is to be German and potentially make friendships for life! The exchange will provide students with the opportunity not only to improve their command of the German language but will also enhance awareness of German culture and the German way of life, which forms so much a part of language learning. To this end, we are organising an exchange trip to our partner school in the region of Baden Württemberg in South-West Germany. The trip is for students in Year 8, 9 & 10s who will be studying German and your son/daughter is invited to participate. Ms Dickinson and Mrs Caswell will be accompanying the students.

The Stromberg Gymnasium, which is a grammar school, was opened in September 1999 and is located in the small and picturesque rural town of Vaihingen approximately twenty-five kilometres north of Stuttgart. Vaihingen is a similar size to Marlborough, with a population of approximately 12,000. There is plenty for young people to see and do in the area.

**It is anticipated that the cost will be £548.00 based on fifteen students attending and will include.**

- Return air travel between London Heathrow & Stuttgart Airport
- Coach transfers in England and Germany
- All excursions in Germany plus day trip to Salisbury with exchange partners in England
- All meals provided by host families.
- Insurance
- DBS certificate processing for all household residence over the age of sixteen. **A meeting will be arranged in the new year to collect DBS documents etc.**

**Not included in the trip cost.**

- Spending money (*up to maximum of €100.00*)

To secure your son/daughters place on the trip an initial deposit of **£75.00 will be required by 15.00hrs on Monday 3 November 2025**. Followed by five instalments as listed below. **Please make note of these instalment dates as reminders will not be sent.**

**Please ensure that payment instalments are paid in full by the due dates. Persistent overdue payment may result in your son/daughter being removed from the trip at your cost.**

Trip deposits will be returned to you should there be insufficient interest in the trip or your son/daughter is not allocated a trip place.

Please note that students will be travelling on their own Passports, and these must be valid for at least six months after the date of return. **A valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) will also be required. Please note that students will not be able to travel without a valid EHIC/GHIC card.**

**Please be advised that by signing up your child up to a school trip you are entering into a financial agreement with St John's to pay the full cost of the trip by the due date advised. Once places have been confirmed trip payments will be non-returnable unless the school cancels the trip.**

**Please note that should parental request withdraw a student unless for a substantiated medical reason, parents will be liable for the full cost of the trip.** All such withdrawals should be discussed, in the first instance, with Mrs Pauline Marshall-Thomas via [trips@stjohns.excalibur.org.uk](mailto:trips@stjohns.excalibur.org.uk) or DD 01672 518896.

**It is imperative that the students who we take on the trip are responsible and can follow instructions. We will not take students who have had any exclusions this academic year or a substantial amount of negative behaviour points.**

The organisation of all trips includes a comprehensive risk assessment. The Principal and Trip Organiser may choose to exclude from the trip any students whose behaviour, attendance or schoolwork is not satisfactory. *Any student withdrawn by St John's for these reasons will be at the expense of the parents. It is not possible to guarantee any refund of monies already committed by St John's and indeed expenses not already covered may be claimed from you.*

Please be aware that the medical information and contact details for your son/daughter that you have supplied for St John's records are printed and taken on the trip by the trip leader and their deputy in case an emergency arises. They are also supplied to the member of the Senior Leadership Team who is point of contact for the trip. The printouts are destroyed once the trip is over. By applying for a place on the trip, you are giving your consent for this information to be used for this purpose.

**If your child is either asthmatic or has anaphylaxis, they must ensure that they always carry their inhaler or EpiPen on them during the trip.**

Please be aware that in the case of an insurance claim being necessary, you will be asked to reimburse St John's for any insurance excess paid on your behalf at the time of treatment in resort. Claims for lost/stolen/damaged personal effects will be paid less any relevant excess.

**Deposit payment and permission must be received by 15.00hrs on Monday 3 November 2025 at the latest.**
