Dear Parents and Carers

Induction Visit – Friday 3rd July 2026 09:00 to 14:10

What the Induction Day programme looks like:

During the Induction visit students should wear their current school uniform and arrive in the Atrium by 09:00, where they will be registered. Students will finish their day at St John's at 14:10.

Students will be involved in a variety of different lessons over the course of the day. This will help them find their way around, moving from classroom to classroom and meeting different teachers.

Medical

If your child has a medical condition or Health Care Plan, please contact our Lead Emergency First Aider, Ms Deery on STJFirstAid@stjohns.excalibur.org.uk, prior to the Induction Day in July.

- All students who have any medical conditions and/or require medication must alert staff when they arrive on their induction day.
- Students with Care Plans must bring their medication and Care Plan to Reception at the start of the day.
- Medication must be named with dosage instructions.
- Medication must be collected on the day.

Equipment

Students should bring the following:

- Medication with dosage instructions and Care Plan if appropriate
- A school bag
- A pencil case
- A bottle of water to drink
- A plastic wallet or large envelope to hold papers/letters
- Emergency contact phone numbers
- Packed lunch or money to buy food from the Atrium restaurant. Please provide your child with change, if possible, bearing in mind the below costs:
 - Hot or cold main meal £2.60, drinks from £1 and cakes from £1

Useful Travel/Transport Information:

Wiltshire Council does not provide school bus transport for the Induction Day. You will need to make your own transport arrangements to and from St John's. If your child needs to be driven to St John's, please car share wherever possible.

At the end of the Induction Day St John's staff will be accompanying children to the car park on the St John's site. If collecting your child by car, please do not park at the end of the car park near the school, as this will block access for the buses.

Several public service buses drop off and pick up at St John's. Your child can use these services by paying for a ticket when they board. You can check bus times at: <https://www.connectingwiltshire.co.uk/getting-around/bus/bus-timetables-maps/> Your child should wait in the atrium until their bus is called. If your child intends to travel by service bus, please ensure they have enough money for both journeys.

If your child is walking home, they will be able to do so at the end of the Induction Day or can wait for a sibling in the atrium.

Children will finish their day at St John's at 14:10. **Please ensure your child knows where they will be collected from at the end of the day.**
