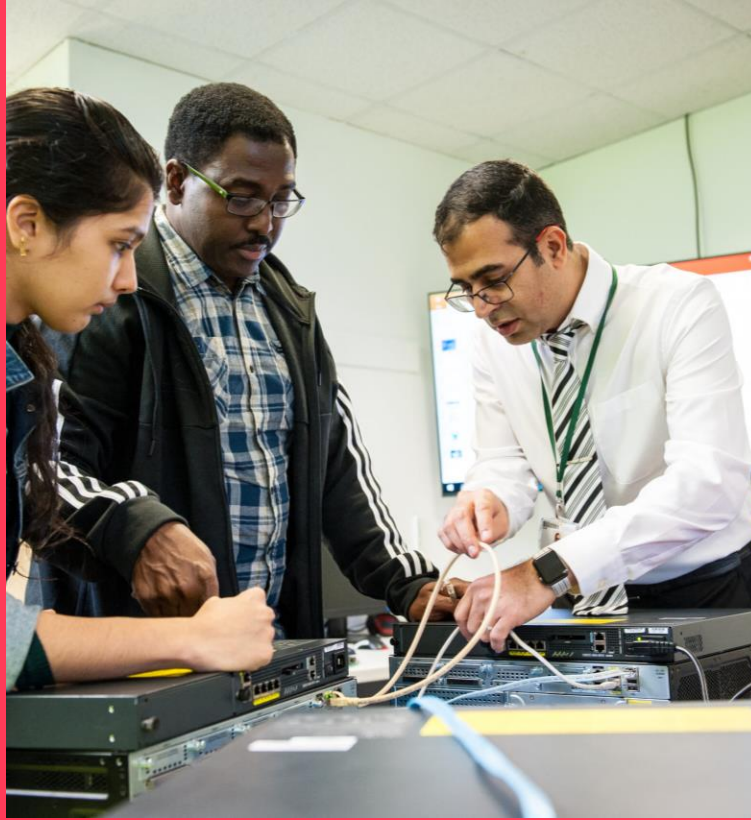

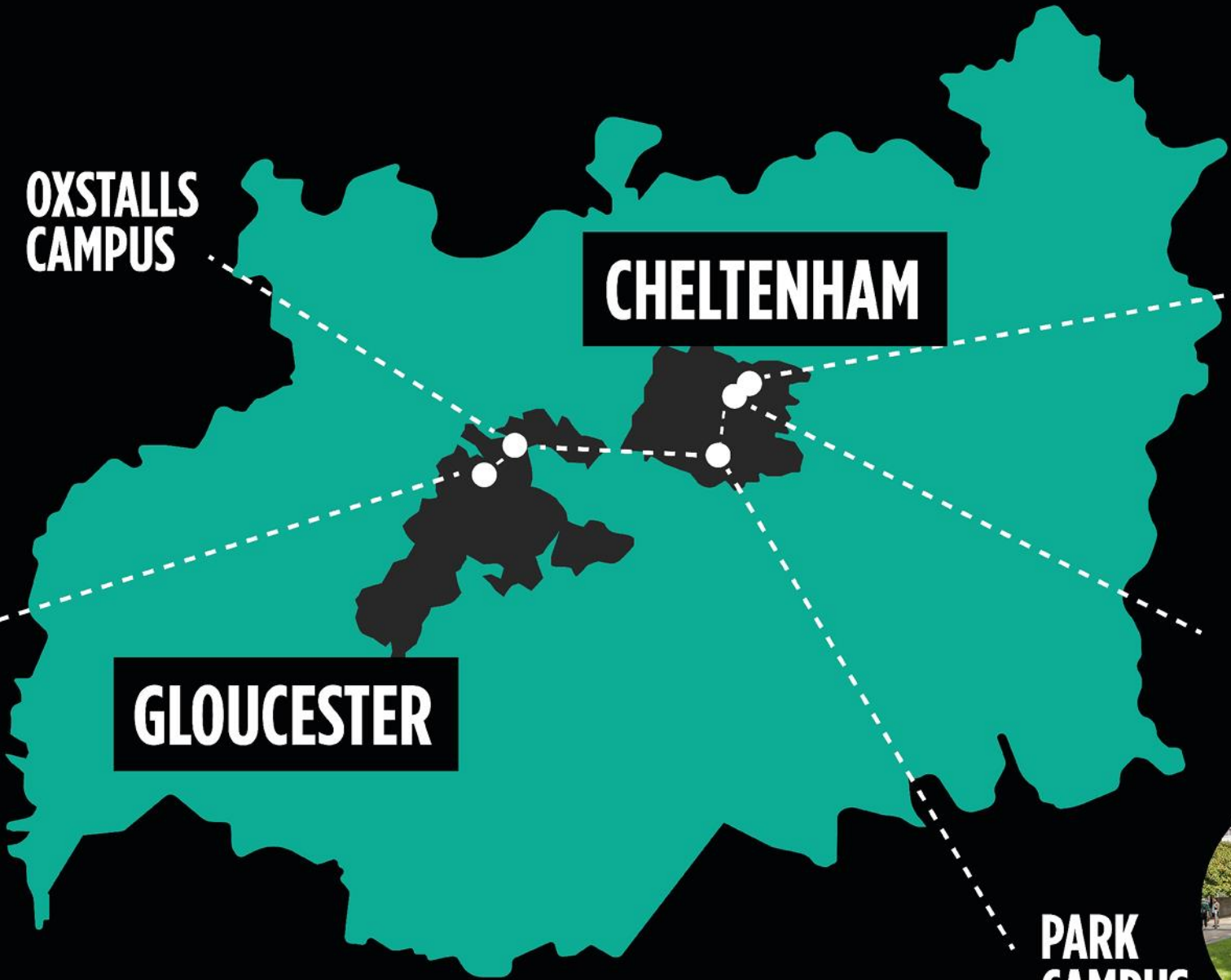

You will have a learner coach and a personal tutor and **access to all the student support services** on offer at University of Gloucestershire.

You have the **full graduation day** with the cap and gown and all the celebrations.



HOW IT WORKS

You work **30+ hours a week** for your employer.

Each degree apprenticeship has a **different delivery model** where you attend university for face-to-face teaching. This **happens in your paid work time**, it can vary from two days every 6-8 weeks, to block release where you study for a full week.

Each week you will have **6 hours in paid work time to complete your studies** and work associated with your degree apprenticeship.
